



Abbey Wood Grange – COVID-19 Policy

Abbey Wood Grange whole heartedly supports the health, safety, and welfare of all our children and families, as well as the local and wider community. They will therefore follow all government and Public England Health guidance and recommendations throughout the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak.

The nursery will remain open where possible. This will be subject to government reviews of the scientific evidence and advice given from the department of education.

1. Families will be required to pay normal fee charges if they choose not to attend nursery, as shielding has now ended.
2. Families will continue to have a contract with Abbey Wood Grange Nursery if they continue to pay fees unless they submit the one month's notice period in writing.
3. Families where a child has been identified as clinically vulnerable are able to return to nursery as per government guidance.
4. All parents are required to be fully supportive of Abbey Wood Grange's operating guidelines during the pandemic and their child's continued place at nursery will be dependent on full co-operation of these measures.
5. We will aim to operate all events as per our schedule; however, adaptations may be made in line with current government advice.
6. Opening hours may be reviewed on a temporary basis during the pandemic if there are further peaks in infection rates and subsequent covid outbreaks.
